Use the following journal writing prompts for your students' daily journal time throughout the week of America's Biggest Bedtime Story. Pick the daily prompt for them, or let them choose one.

- Make up a name for the vehicle the Cat uses to clean up his mess. Would you like one of these vehicles? Why or why not?
- Imagine that the Cat came to your house one rainy afternoon. What kinds of games might he play there?
- Would you tell your mother if the Cat in the Hat came to your house?
- What do you do when it is rainy outside?
- What are the rules in your house if your parents are not home?
- Who do you think was the most responsible character in the story? Explain your answer.
- Imagine that you become Thing One or Thing Two for an afternoon. Describe your afternoon.
- Do you think their mother ever found out what they did that rainy day? Why or why not?
- Do you think Sally and her brother had fun with the Cat in the Hat there? Explain your answer.
- Thing One and Thing Two are loose in your house and you do not have a net. Describe how you might catch them.
- Describe a day in the life of the Cat in the Hat. Where does he live? What does he do? Does he let Thing One and Thing Two out at home or do they live in the big red box?
